## 1 DEFINITIONS

### 1.1 Scope and Sub-Scope Definitions

### 1.2 Fee Categories and Time of Effectiveness

GLOBALG.A.P. fees are defined according to the following fee categories:

#### Producer Registration Fee (→ Chapter 2)

Both the Producer Registration Fee and the Certificate License Fee are linked to the certificate cycle. For producers that are already certified end of 2010, the 2011 fee structure will become effective with the certificate cycle(s) that start/restart in 2011. The Producer Registration Fee applies to each individual producer (also to each producer group member) and has to be paid per calendar year according to certificate cycle.

#### Certificate License Fee (→ Chapter 3)

Certificate License Fee applies to each issued certificate and is paid by the certification body and to be paid per calendar year according to certificate cycle.

#### Certification Body License Fee (→ Chapter 4)

The Certification Body License Fee is paid for general License to carry out certification activities within the GLOBALG.A.P. framework and is paid by the certification body on an annual basis.

#### GRASP Assessment Fee (→ Chapter 5)

The GRASP Assessment Fee applies to each GRASP assessment that is carried out and is paid by the certification body.

#### Certification Body Training Fee (→ Chapter 6)

Several training requirements ensure the quality and qualification of GLOBALG.A.P. approved auditors and inspectors. The GLOBALG.A.P. training offer will be broadened and more targeted to certification body in-house trainers and special qualification for auditors conducting group certification.

#### Voluntary GLOBALG.A.P. Association Membership Fee (→ Chapter 7)

GLOBALG.A.P. members benefit in many ways: they contribute to the governance of GLOBALG.A.P., participate in the standard setting and decision making process and have a say in the approving procedure of benchmarking other standards. In addition to these active participatory rights, GLOBALG.A.P. members profit from a range of special services and discounts. GLOBALG.A.P. offers three different types of memberships: for producers/suppliers, for retailers/ food service members and associate members.

#### Benchmarking Fee (→ Chapter 8)

Owners of Good Agricultural Practice (G.A.P.) standards worldwide can seek to demonstrate equivalence with GLOBALG.A.P. through an independent benchmarking process. The benchmarking fees are service fees covering the application and approval procedure guided by the GLOBALG.A.P. Secretariat. The fee does not include the cost of evaluation by external expert(s).

### 1.3 Other Definitions

#### Covered/Non-Covered Crop

Covered crop is primarily intended to mean, "Produced in a greenhouse". A crop is considered "covered" when it is grown beneath or within a structure - with or without building foundations - where the cropping environment has some kind of overhead protection (not including individual plant/tree covers, nets, low tunnels, hail protection, mulches or anything that is not a greenhouse) during the production of that crop. The cover can be made of plastic, glass or other similar materials, and must be accessible by persons (walk-in possible). Any farm can have part of its crop covered and another part not covered, but this must be declared separately at registration, detailing the sum of the respective areas (covered or not covered) according to the definition above. Any other production is considered as "Non-covered-crop"
